## **Aerial Work Platforms**

Aerial Work Platforms - There are many attachments designed for lift trucks that can be used to be able to help expand the functionality of your lift truck and allow you to carry objects, handle materials with out difficulty or to accomplish clean-up tasks.

Several attachments were specially meant for the blades themselves. For instance, fork extensions can be utilized if you require a lot more blade length, which increases lifting capacity. Fork extensions come in lengths ranging from forty eight to one hundred twenty inches. Triangular or rounded attachments are another type utilized whenever transferring rolled material in order to make certain it does not roll off of the standard flat blades.

Examples of lifting attachments include pivoting and telescoping crane or boom accessories. They can come in a number of different styles and are most often utilized for moving poles, metal bars, lumber and other types of bulky objects. Other attachments like for instance various styles of hooks and hook plates are existing so as to carry objects utilizing a chain or sling. Slab filters and magnetic filters are other things that can be used together with hook attachments. Slab lifters are specialized attachments which are meant for carrying a variety of materials that are delivered in a sheet or slab format. Carpet poles and rug rams are other lifting tools which attach to your lift truck to be able to make moving rolls of carpet easier. The accessory hooks onto the forklift's forks and has a pole that goes through the center of the carpet roll.

There are many other types of lift truck attachments which can be used for facility maintenance such as snow blades. These forks connect to front end loaders and can transport materials such as dirt, soil and snow. Other common cleanup attachments comprise magnetic sweepers and standard sweepers. Standard sweepers includes a broom that the lift truck forks connect onto for sweeping large spaces like for instance factory floors, parking lots and warehouse. The magnetic sweeper is the same except that it has a magnetic plate instead of bristles. The magnetic sweeper is utilized in areas where there is lots of metal fragments like on shop floors for instance. Sweepers have widths up to 60 inches and this surface area makes clean up effortless and fast.

A material spreader is one more lift truck attachment which is normally utilized at facilities. These spreaders are helpful for various applications like for instance spreading fertilizers, insecticides, seeds, ice melt, rock salt and pellets.

Another optional lifting accessory are work platforms. These can be used by several different companies daily. Platforms may range in size from 36" x 36" to up to 60" x 60". A few models may be accessible and are capable of folding up and storing into a smaller place. Work platforms are designed to raise staff up to an overhead location with the use of the lift truck. Larger platform units have added space for personnel so as to bring tools and other essential items meant for the task. Usually work platforms are made of poly material or steel.
